Today's Scripture

Psalm 118:1-2, 14-24

- 1. give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his steadfast love endures forever!
- 2. Let Israel say, "His steadfast love endures forever."
- 14. The LORD is my strength and my might; he has become my salvation.
- 15. There are glad songs of victory in the tents of the righteous: "The right hand of the LORD does valiantly;
- 16. the right hand of the LORD is exalted; the right hand of the LORD does valiantly."
- 17. I shall not die, but I shall live and recount the deeds of the LORD.
- 18. The LORD has punished me severely, but he did not give me over to death.
- 19. Open to me the gates of righteousness, that I may enter through them and give thanks to the LORD.
- 20. This is the gate of the LORD; the righteous shall enter through it.
- 21. I thank you that you have answered me and have become my salvation.
- 22. The stone that the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone.
- 23. This is the Lord's doing; it is marvelous in our eyes.
- 24. This is the day that the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

1 Corinthians 15:19-26

- 19. If for this life only we have hoped in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied.
- 20. But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have died.
- 21. For since death came through a human, the resurrection of the dead has also come through a human,
- 22. for as all die in Adam, so all will be made alive in Christ.
- 23. But each in its own order: Christ the first fruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ.
- 24. Then comes the end, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father, after he has destroyed every ruler and every authority and power.
- 25. For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet.
- 26. The last enemy to be destroyed is death.
