Today's Scripture

Psalm 71:1-6

- 1. In you, O LORD, I take refuge; let me never be put to shame.
- 2. In your righteousness deliver me and rescue me; incline your ear to me and save me.
- 3. Be to me a rock of refuge, a strong fortress to save me, for you are my rock and my fortress.
- 4. Rescue me, O my God, from the hand of the wicked, from the grasp of the unjust and cruel.
- 5. For you, O Lord, are my hope, my trust, O LORD, from my youth.
- 6. From my birth I have leaned upon you, my protector since my mother's womb. My praise is continually of you.

Luke 4:21-30

- 21. Then he began to say to them, "Today this scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."
- 22. All spoke well of him and was amazed at the gracious words that came from his mouth. They said, "Is this not Joseph's son?"
- 23. He said to them, "Doubtless you will quote to me this proverb, 'Doctor, cure yourself!' And you will say, 'Do here also in your hometown the things that we have heard you did at Capernaum.'"
- 24. And he said, "Truly I tell you; no prophet is accepted in his hometown.
- 25. But the truth is, there were many widows in Israel in the time of Elijah, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months and there was a severe famine over all the land,
- 26. yet Elijah was sent to none of them except to a widow at Zarephath in Sidon.
- 27. There were also many with a skin disease in Israel in the time of the prophet Elisha, and none of them was cleansed except Naaman the Syrian."
- 28. When they heard this, all in the synagogue were filled with rage.
- 29. They got up, drove him out of the town, and led him to the brow of the hill on which their town was built, so that they might hurl him off the cliff.
- 30. But he passed through the middle of them and went on his way.
